In support of Alpha Tau Omega National Headquarters' decision to remove the chapter's charter, effective immediately- Indiana University suspends the chapter indefinitely. The organization will cease and desist all activities and disband.

The University prohibits retaliation against those who file complaints or otherwise participate in the disciplinary process. Violations includes but are not limited to any type of phone call, voice mail message, personal contact, social media (Twitter, Facebook, etc.), text messaging, letter, email, message delivered by a third party, being in their presence, or contact with other's personal property. Failure to comply with this order will result in penalties, including, but not limited to, filing of charges under the Student Code of Conduct for individuals.
