- There are 274 new full-time faculty members.
- Twenty-eight percent of the new faculty members are tenured or tenure track faculty and librarians.
- Eleven percent of the new faculty members are lecturers, clinical professors or professors of practice.
- Thirty-five percent of the new faculty members are research scientists, research associates or postdoctoral fellows.
- Twenty-six percent of the new faculty members are visiting professors.
